In addition, our local depots at Widnes, Boston and Grangemouth can supply 3 packs or less and even a split pack service to help with customers' stock holding. We work closely with our colleagues at the mills and we are often able to produce customer specific sizes or grades - please ask for details.

Thermowood timber can either be stained or left to weather naturally and is therefore an ideal material for use as external weatherboarding, claddings, furniture, screening, modular buildings and decking.

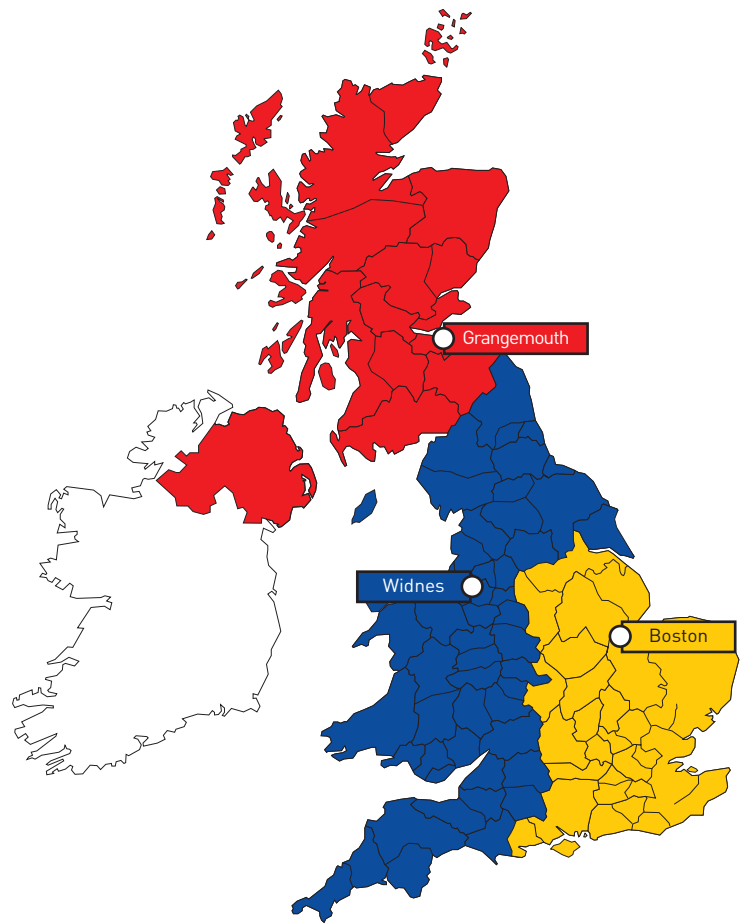
